Programs & Services

HOME VISITS

Home or on-site visits are available through Children's Integrated Services (CIS) for families who have a child with medical conditions or developmental delays, a need for family or parenting support, mental health, or preventative nursing services.

CHILD CARE SUPPORT SERVICES

Referral and financial assistance for child care, summer camp, before/after school care for children ages 0 - 12 years old.

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

PlayWorks Child Center provides quality childcare and preschool in a nurturing environment to children 6 weeks to 6 years.

WELCOME BABY & DIAPER BANK

Any parent or guardian with a baby living in our service region can access free diapers, wipes and formula, as well as a free Welcome Baby Bag filled with gifts and resources.

PARENT EDUCATION & SUPPORT

Evidenced-based and informed curriculums, support groups, resources and information for parents and caregivers are available both online and in-person.

PLAYGROUPS
